
These instructions are written for Microsoft Word 2010, 2013, 2016, 2019 and 365.

## **ENABLING MACROS**

In order to be able to use the macros used and described in the template, you must enable them first. To do this, proceed as follows:

- 1. Create a folder for your thesis in Explorer, e.g. C:\thesis.
- 2. Copy the template for academic work into this folder.
- 3. Make sure that Word or all open Word documents are closed.
- 4. Then open Word.
- 5. Click on **File > Options.**
- 6. Select **Trust Center**.


**Click Trust Center Settings.** 



## 7. Select **Trusted Locations**.

## Click Add new location.

Click **Browse** and select the location of the template (e.g. C:\thesis).



- 8. Confirm with **OK**.
- 9. Go to the Explorer and to the folder where you saved the template; now open the template with a double-click.
- 10. Now you can use macros.
- 11. Save the thesis as a .docx document in the selected folder (e.g. C:\thesis). If you select a different folder, macros will no longer be available to you.
