
The International Foundation Program is perfect for students who ...

## Admission requirements

- → A-Level / High School Diploma or equivalent:

  If the Austrian Higher Education Entrance Qualification is not yet met, the required level can be acquired within the International Foundation Program. In general, A-level is required, but in some cases excellent performance in AS-level and GCSE-level courses might qualify as well
- → English Language Certificate B2 Accepted certificates are IELTS (6.0), TOEFL (79), Cambridge Certificates, not older than 2 years.




Minimum requirements for successfully completing:

#### \*German

Several options available, based on your level of skills!

- → For English-taught Bachelor programs: 3 ECTS course per semester based on your level of skills you will be tested to find the right course.
- → For German-taught Bachelor programs: Beginner level = 9 ECTS German course, all other levels (A2, B1, B2, C1, C2) = 3 ECTS German course
- → Those who are only taking a 3 ECTS German course are allowed to select an additional 3 ECTS elective course.




