## International

Logistics Management is a global challenge. That is why from autumn 2025 onwards the degree will be offered in both German and English. Full-time students complete the first four semesters in English and spend a mandatory semester abroad at one of our 100 partner universities. During the first four semesters, our international students get to learn German so that they can complete the final two semesters of their studies in German.

## Career Profile

Logistics professionals shape their future in retail companies, manufacturing companies, logistics service providers and consulting companies. They handle the management of procurement and distribution departments, analyze data in order to obtain information for more sustainable strategies of logistical processes, are responsible for warehouses and vehicle fleets and work on projects involving multiple departments to improve customer service and grow the company's success.

## Good to Know

- In recent rankings, International Logistics Management has always been rated the best of over 70 bachelor's programs in economics at universities of applied science in Austria.
- Logistics is decisive for the boom in online retailers. Logistics ensures that the ordered goods reliably arrive on time.
- Logistics will make a crucial contribution to achieving the EU's strict climate goals ("EU Green Deal").
- Logistics ensures that even in times of crisis (Covid-19 pandemic, war in Ukraine, etc.) we can receive urgently needed goods and food.
- **New starting autumn 2025:** The full-time ILM program first to fourth semester will be held in English, so that even students without knowledge of German can enroll. During these semesters, non-German-speaking students are offered assistance to help them learn German. The ILM program final two fifth and sixth semesters are held in German. This is intended to give all foreign students the opportunity to take up a professional career in an Austrian company or in the German-speaking world.
- The part-time courses are held in German, with the exception of the third semester in which many lectures are in English.

## Practical Experience and Research

The largest Austrian research institution for logistics (logistikum.at) located at the FH OÖ Campus Steyr ensures that the latest research results are incorporated into teaching and organizes networking with logistics companies through the Logistics Network Association (vnl.at) in Steyr.
